College AND Career Ready

- Most careers require post high school training
- Less than 30% of jobs require a Bachelor's Degree (4 year college) or higher
- 6 Year Plan- high school plus two years: Senior Exit Interview
- Will be part of the new API (how high schools are evaluated)
- Explore your interests in 9th & 10th grade
- Select your pathway in 10th grade when you register for 11th & 12th grade classes

Pathways

- Take specific classes related to your career interest
- Both 4 year university and 2 year college bound options
- Explore careers and job requirements
- Interact with community employers and higher education
- Guest speakers, conferences & field trips
- Looks good on college and scholarship applications
- Pathway Cord for graduation upon completion
